





This Insitutional Summary Report presents aggregate scores for examinees who took *College BASE* and who indicated enrollment at your institution. The Assessment Resource Center assigned the "Test Date" to provide a unique identifier based on the actual testing date or a date proximate to the insitution's testing period. This summary presents *College BASE* scores in two dimensions of achievement: Subject Scores in English, mathematics, science, and social studies; and Competency Scores in interpretive, strategic, and adaptive reasoning.

The Subject Scores indicate examinees' familiarity with traditional general education skills and knowledge. Subjects are divided into levels that become increasingly more specific: from Subjects to Clusters to Skills. This summary reports Subject and Cluster scores based on a 40 to 560 scale, with 300 being average. This summary displays the median score and standard deviation for each *College BASE* Subject and Cluster. Skill scores are reported as the numbers and percentages of students scoring high (H), medium (M), and low (L). Competency Scores show examinees' capability in cognitive processing skills as they apply to all Subjects. These scores are reported as High, Medium, or Low. This summary provides the numbers and corresponding percentages of examinees that achieved high, medium, and low ratings when each student has taken all four Subjects.

The Composite Score, representing institutional performance on the examination when all four subjects are administered, is also reported on a 40 to 560 scale. For Missouri institutions and *College Base 1:1* administrations the Composite Score represents the mean of the four institutional Subject Scores. The median of all individual student Composite Scores is reported for all other administrations.
